Policy Statement:

All guidance published by the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) which is a 'Do Not Do' recommendation is not normally funded by NHS.

Rationale:

The ICB only routinely funds treatments of proven clinical effectiveness. Therefore any treatments or procedures listed within the NICE 'Do not Do' should not be under-taken and will not be funded by the NHS.
